**Parking** – No problem finding a convenient parking space thanks to the big lot that runs along the beach; and it's only \$0.75 per hour.

**Food and beverage** - Public pavilions and BBQ grills are found along the beach for your own picnic or you can enjoy a variety of restaurants and bars just across the street.

**Beachcombers** - Collecting shells and shark teeth may be something new for many people. But it is quite common here as each new wave brings in thousands of seashells and prehistoric fossilized sharks teeth. Why not find your own and make a necklace?

**Restrooms** – There are convenient restrooms and outdoor showers on the boardwalk that extends along the beach.

**Drum Circle** - The Englewood Beach Drum Circle gathers every Sunday, weather permitting, one hour before sunset. Everyone is welcome to drum, hula hoop, dance or just enjoy the music as they drum the sun down together on the beach!
