“Net migration measures the number of people who moved into the metro area from some other part of the US or another country, minus the number of people who left the metro area over that period”.

#3 Punta Gorda, Florida – Bordering Port Charlotte

About 36,551 people moved to this area of Florida between the years of 2010-2018, about 22.8% of the population. The area’s population as of 2010 was 159,978 and counting!

#5 North Port – Sarasota – Bradenton, Florida

This well sought after part of Florida experienced an increase in population of about 140,889 between the years of 2010-2018. This new migration accounted for about 20.1% of the area’s population of 702,281, according to the last census!
